BEING A PARISH COUNCILLOR

The Council has a number of duties and many powers, which are administered on behalf of the residents of the Parish.

A Parish Councillor needs to be committed to the local Community and therefore a Member's input is important and a hands-on approach is needed on some occasions.

Full Council meetings are held once a month (normally the second Monday) except August. These are held at the Hullbridge Centre in Windermere Avenue and commence at 19.30 hrs. In addition to the monthly meetings there are various committees, which meet on an ad hoc basis. Membership of these committees is voluntary.

All Members have to abide to a Code of Conduct as well as Standing Orders, Financial Regulations and other Polices adopted by the Parish Council.
