Police including Superintendent Cat Barrie, Lead for the Special Constabulary and her colleagues and Inspector Cathy Calder, the Castle Point & Rochford Community Policing Team Inspector, they were joined by Roger Hirst, Essex Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner and Parish Councillors at the Parish Office.

SC Dan O'Connell will volunteer a minimum of 16 hours each month at different times and days in Hullbridge to target and disrupt anti-social behaviour, respond to community concerns and carry out high visibility patrols. The Specials have the same full policing powers and uniform as regular police officers. This will host the Annual Remembrance Services as the current village sign area will be narrowed due to the ghost lane into Watery Lane.
