In May 2017 I was elected Chairman for a second term and during the year I have attended a number of events both in an official and an unofficial capacity. I would like to take this opportunity to thank Cllr Mrs.

Lesley Spencer for all her input

as a Parish Councillor as unfortunately during the year she decided to step down. The vacancy was quickly filled by Mr. Danny Gatehouse, who has previously been a Councillor and is a valued member of the team This Parish Council has worked hard for the interests of its residents and we have made representation on a number of outside bodies. including the Essex Coastal Forum, ECC Transport, Citizens Advice Bureau and the Rochford Hundred Association of Local Councils. Malyons Farm Development is ongoing, the outline planning permission is granted and of the time of writing we are waiting for the Reserve Matters to be validated. Once this happens we will run an open public session for residents to view the finer details of the proposed development and the opportunity to forward us your comments to assist us with our formal response to the Rochford District Council. We will continue to meet with the Developers to discuss the Section 106 Agreement regarding the Youth facilities as well as other matters. The Remembrance Services are very important to the Parish Council and this year we laid

wreaths at the Hullbridge / Rayleigh / Hockley Services. I would like to thank my Vice Chairman Cllr Miss A Marriott and fellow Councillors for their efforts over the last year, also to the Clerk to the Council and her staff for the efficient administration and the maintenance around the village. ## <u>Finance/ Policy /</u> <u>Appointments Committee</u>

The Parish Council strives to achieve "Best Value" for all its expenditure, whilst abiding by our financial regulations ensuring we get good value for money and obtaining the most competitive prices.

We have a 5 year Financial Forecast and Action Plan and have adopted and updated our Policies and Procedures. Our budget for 2017/2018 was £148,777 and this was spent on a number of responsibilities.

#### Some of which were:

- Floral baskets/planters
- Allotments
- Free use of Pooles Lane car park
- Managing and maintaining Kendal Nature Reserve
- Events including the Christmas Fayre
- Street lighting in un-adopted roads
- CCTV in the car park and Ferry Road
- Maintenance of street furniture, Rose Garden, village Memorial, some grass verges and footpaths (5/12).
- Recreation Ground Toilets (April-October)
- Play Ground **Improvements**

The Parish Council also continues to provide support to a number of organisations including Essex Air Ambulance and Citizens Advice Bureau. We do have a grant scheme where organisations can apply http://www.hullbridgepc.co.uk

**Grant Funding -** We have actively sought grant funding and we were successful in securing funding to refurbish the pond area in Kendal Park NR. We will be having a pond area with a platform for pond dipping and a marsh / boggy area, this will provide habitats for a wide range of species and plants also give a source of water for other wildlife. The fishing boat was installed and a real asset to the park and visitors. This year we will be

enjoyed by residents and changing the safety matting to rubber surface area.

#### **General Purposes Committee**

Under this Committee's remit it looks after the Parish Council's street scene assets, which includes Parish street lights, teen shelter, public seating, notice boards, bins, War Memorial, village signs, green gym, bus shelters and play equipment.

Pooles Lane car park we are pleased that this is continuing to be free. Unfortunately our maintenance staff are continuing to pick up a large amount of rubbish left there each day.

Over 180 Christmas parcels were delivered to the elderly residents, contributions were given by Riverside Primary School and the School Council kindly packed them. If you are 80 this year or if you know of anyone please let the Office know so we can make sure you are on our list.

## <u>Parks / Open Spaces /</u> <u>Conservation / Footpaths</u> Committee

We have continued to make improvements to the play space at the Recreation Ground and the arrival of the play boat has been a big hit, the Play Area provides play equipment for all ages, including seating/picnic tables and a sun canopy, this park is very popular and used by many.

We are in discussions with Rochford District Council regarding the old Pavilion and its future and we are continuing to fund the opening of the toilets as we appreciate this is a necessity for users of the park but we hope that we can make improvements to the toilet facility.

The footpath link to the Dome to provide a circular walk is still being investigated we are we are hoping the scheme that Natural England are currently running to reinstate coastal footpaths might be able to assist us.

**Kendal Park NR** is managed by the Parish Council and we have a Management Plan in place to secure the future of the Reserve. We have had to carry out continued coppicing work due to Ash Tree Die Back and to strengthen the Nature Reserve. Over the last 2 years we have planted nearly 400 tree whips but sadly most have been damaged. We would like to thank 1st Hullbridge Scouts who have built a fantastic bug hotel and are in the process of putting together some bird boxes, Essex Wildlife will also be installing and monitoring an Owl Box, wildlife in the Reserve is improving. This year we will be replenishing the footpath with cockle shell which visitors have liked. We have also installed rubbish bins and dog bins which we hope will be used. Cllr D Borg.
