Malyons Farm Development

Construction is well underway, BDW has sent over 2000 copies of their Newsletter to many Hullbridge residents and a copy can be viewed on our Website / Noticeboards for those who did not receive one.

After delays due to utility issues BDW started work on 22/7/2019 with the roundabout works programme which will last for 12 weeks. Site Work times will be between 07.30-19.00 hrs Monday - Friday and 07.30 - 17.00 hrs on Saturday with no working on Sunday's Due to the Ghost Lane taking a considerable chunk of land around the current Memorial on the corner of Watery lane we have negotiated with BDW and they have agreed to build a temporary Memorial opposite (on their site) for residents to lay wreaths/flowers for loved ones also for future Remembrance Services. Once the proposed Sales unit is removed then a permanent War Memorial and Garden of Reflection will be built. (Design to be agreed - so if any resident has any suggestions please forward them on to us). The current two benches and Village sign will remain in situ.

Kendal Park Nature Reserve Works to the pond will commence in November, the pond will be completely dug out and redone due to a leak, so there will be some footpath closures. As always please keep you dogs on leads.
