Hullbridge Parish Council would like to wish all residents a very Happy and Healthy Christmas and New Year.

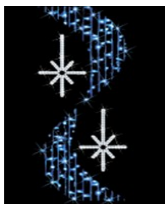


Unfortunately this year's Christmas Fayre has had to be cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
